



EU AI Act self-declaration – IVA Pro Vehicle Make Model

Subject:

Self-Declaration of Compliance of **IVA Pro Vehicle Make Model** with the EU AI Act.

Description and type of the system:

IVA Pro Vehicle Make Model is a video analytics software available for selected Bosch IP cameras.

The intended use of IVA Pro Vehicle Make Model is to detect and identify the make and model of moving cars, vans, buses and trucks to enable a more refined forensic search for vehicles, especially when license plate recognition is restricted or prohibited due to privacy concerns.

IVA Pro Vehicle Make Model runs in real-time on the camera and uses the video feed from the camera as input. It detects and recognizes the make (brand) and model (type) of moving vehicles (car, van, bus, truck), but not their identity, and adds this information to the video. The metadata can then be requested by external software like traffic management systems.

IVA Pro Vehicle Make Model is not designed or intended for use in hazardous environments requiring fail-safe performance, including, without limitation, in the operation of nuclear facilities, aircraft navigation or control systems, air traffic control, life support machines, weapons systems, or any other application in which the failure of the software could lead to death, personal injury or severe physical or environmental damages (“high risk activities”). The Software is not designed or warranted to be suitable for use in connection with high-risk activities in connection with Art. 6 para. 1, 2 AI Act.
